- will transfer into a BA or BS degree at a four-year institution;
- will put the transfer student at junior status when admitted; and
- will allow the transfer student to graduate with the BA or BS degree in no more than 60 credits of additional coursework, for a total of 120 credits (126 for ed prep).
- NOTE: the work products for engineering may result in an AA/AS of more than 60 credits, and a bachelor's degree in more than 120 credits, provided the degrees can be completed within two years and four years, respectively
