Being an Ambassador

Sharing the revised Competency Criteria at your institution

Explain the process used to revise and the broad level of feedback contributed in doing so:

Two-year effort; multiple conversations with representation from both 2- and 4-year faculty; feedback and support from GE Council; guidance and support from AAC&U

Address concerns while staying connected to the ultimate goal of improving student learning:

Strong connections to national efforts around transferability, assessment of learning, and accreditation



Process & Timeline, Pt. I

- <u>Phase 1</u>: Fac2Fac participants provided feedback to CDHE on content area and competency criteria. DEADLINE: December 11, 2015 - completed.
- Phase 2: All faculty review.

DEADLINE: March 1, 2016 - completed.

Phase 2.5: F2F participants finalize.

DEADLINE: Today

- Phase 3: FINAL review by GEC and Lisa/Shelly. DEADLINE: May 9, 2016.
- <u>Phase 4:</u> CCHE discussion April 1, 2016 (completed) and final approval June 2, 2016.

Fall 2016: GT-CO1, 2 & 3 and GT-MA1 Review
