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What is Dual Enrollment?

- Bridge an Associate's to a Bachelor's
 - Complete BSN requirements alongside ADN prerequisites and nursing courses
- Maximize time and financial aid
 - Take a majority of courses at the community college
- Dedicated advising relationship
 Guided advising pathway



What makes our model successful?

- Guided advising with a 1 on 1 relationship
- Systemic support at MSU Denver
 - Admissions
 - Advising
 - Transfer Services
- Buy-in from students
- Online coursework and flexibility



What are our challenges?

- Dual Enrollment Coordinator Position
 - Funding
 - Turnover
- Student Population
 - Online Working Adults
 - Parenting
 - Career Changers
- Extreme flexibility
 - Stopping out
 - Taking fewer classes



Program_Data

- \$200,000 over 3+ years
- 1000 individual student touches in 2016
- 6 partners, 9 campuses
- 172 students in BRNCO Program Overall
 - 60 Dual Enrollment, ~35% of overall enrollment
 - 26% of Fall 2016 starting class
 - 57% of Spring 2017 starting class
 - 90% of Summer 2017 starting class
- 215 additional students in the Pathway
- 5 BSN graduates
