Additional issues:

The total CR for General Education Requirements + total CR for ART requirements = 49-51 CR, which leaves 9-11 open credits.

The group voted to delete the Comm. College Speech course requirements.

The group was comprised of 8 representatives from some 2-year colleges, and representatives from all 4-year institutions with the exception of Adams State [Art degree with Art History emphasis], CSU-Pueblo [no Art History degree], and Western State [Art degree with Art History emphasis].

The group voted unanimously to approve all courses as outlined above, with the following exceptions: CU-Boulder abstained; UNC did not vote due to early departure.

¹ Students planning to transfer to CSU for completion of the BA in Art History must complete two semesters of one foreign language for their electives OR be able to pass the CSU Foreign Language placement exam at the sophomore level. It may not be possible to complete the BA in Art History in two years without this prior foreign language competency.
