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Prior Year Revision System

- Components will be open for revision during their regular data collection period
 - Example: Revisions to the Completions component will need to be made during the fall collection period.

 - Institutional Characteristics, Completions, Fall Enrollment
- TRP: Improvements to Completions, 12/09
- TRP: Improvements Human Resources, 6/10
- 2010 Standard Occupational Classification (SOC)
- NCES
 - Institutional Characteristics, Student Financial Aid

- Posted last Sept. in Data Provider Center and Help menu
 - Document describing changes
 - Preview screens and instructions
 - Survey materials, 2012-13 column
 - HR posted in Nov.
- All data collection changes for 2012-13 have been approved by OMB

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Institutional Characteristics

- Distance Education
 - Add item to collect whether distance ed is offered and at what level

What will this change look like?

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IC/SFA

- IC in Fall
 - Collect cost data for 2012-13 only
 - Display cost data for 2011-12, 2010-11, 2009-10
 - Use PYR to revise 2011-12, **2010-11, 2009-10, 2008-09**
- SFA in Winter
 - Collect fin aid data for 2011-12 only
 - Display fin aid data for 2010-11, 2009-10
 - Use PYR to revise **2010-11, 2009-10, 2008-09**
- CATC 2013 Net Price
 - All data from 2011-12 PYR: **2010-11, 2009-10, 2008-09**

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Fall Enrollment

- Distance Education
 - Add new screens to collect data on the # of students enrolled in *any* distance ed and the # enrolled *exclusively* in distance ed
 - Break out by level (undergraduate, graduate)
 - Break out by student location
 - In same state as institution
 - In US but not in same state
 - Outside US

What will these changes look like?

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12-month Enrollment (4-yr institutions)

- FTE
 - Eliminate collection of doctor's-professional practice instructional activity (now included with graduate activity)
 - Add item to collect FTE enrollment for doctor's-professional practice students

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What will these changes look like?

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Completions

- Distance Education
 - Add item to collect which programs are available to be completed completely by distance ed, by CIP code and award level

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Completions

- Completers
 - Add item to collect total # of *students* who earned degrees or certificates, by race/ethnicity and gender

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Completions

- Add items to collect #s of *students* who earned degrees or certificates, separately by (1) gender, (2) race/ethnicity, and (3) age*, for the following 7 award categories:
 - <1-yr certificates
 - 1<4 yr certificates
 - Associate's degrees
 - Bachelor's degrees
 - Postbacc & Post-master's certificates
 - Master's degrees
 - Doctor's degrees

* Age categories are: <18, 18-24, 25-39, 40+, unk

What will these changes look like?

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Graduation Rates

- GR, not GRS

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HR and 2010 SOC

- Changes to *occupational categories* on IPEDS Human Resources component to align with 2010 Standard Occupational Classification System
- Institutions need to be ready to report in 2012-13 using the new categories
 - Each job at institution needs to be categorized according to 2010 SOC

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Highlights of Occupational Category Changes

- Grouped by discipline instead of skill level
 - New: engineers, engineering techs all in 17-0000
 - Old: engineers in Other Profs, techs in Tech & Para
- Loss of a lot of trend data
- 2 groups won't change, except for name
 - Management; Office & Administrative Support
- PI, IRPS, PR, PPS won't change
 - Reported under 25-1000 "Postsecondary Teachers," but disaggregated

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Human Resources (all degree-granting)

- Add SQ: does institution have grad assts?
- *EAP (Part A): Occupation x tenure x FT/PT x med/non-med*
 - Revise Primarily Instruction so that data are reported for 3 subcategories:
 - Exclusively credit
 - Exclusively not-for-credit
 - Combination credit/not-for-credit

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Human Resources (all degree-granting)

- *Salaries (Part E): Salary outlays*
 - Eliminate contract length differentiation
 - Add column after salary outlays to collect # of months covered by salary outlays
 - To calculate a weighted monthly average salary
 - New worksheet to help calculate # of staff reported and total # of months covered

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Human Resources
(all degree-granting)

- *Salaries (Part E): Salary outlays*
 - Add additional screen to collect salary outlays for other FT staff
 - Occupational categories will be the new ones based on 2010 SOC
 - NOT disaggregated by race/ethnicity or gender

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Human Resources
(degree-granting 15+)

- *Fall Staff (Part G): Tenure x rank x R/E/G for IRPS*
 - Eliminate non-instructional research and public service FT staff (to align with Salaries)
- *Fall Staff (Part I): Occupation x R/E/G for other FT*
 - Add items to include the research and public service categories that were eliminated from reporting in Part G

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Human Resources
(degree-granting 15+)

- Add SQ: does institution have tenure system?
 - Y = 6 categories; N = 4 categories
- *Fall Staff (Part G): Tenure x rank x R/E/G*
 - Add the following non-tenure track contract categories:
 - Multi-year contract
 - Annual contract
 - Less than annual contract
 - Without faculty status

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New HR component structure....

- No more references to *EAP, Fall Staff*
- Survey will start with R/E/G
- Then, occupation x tenure x FT/PT x med/non-med
- Next, *Salaries* worksheet & outlays
- Last, new hires

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IPEDS R&D

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Role of NPEC

- Promote the quality, comparability and utility of postsecondary data and information that support policy development at the federal, state, and institution levels
- NCES has assigned NPEC the specific responsibility for developing a research and development agenda for IPEDS

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Who Is NPEC?

- 15 members:
 - Six data representatives from ACE, NAICU, APLU, AASCU, APLU, and AACCC
 - Nine representatives from:
 - a non-profit college;
 - a for-profit college;
 - a community college;
 - a public 4-year college;
 - a regional organization (e.g., SREB, WICHE);
 - a data user groups (e.g., TICAS, IHEP);
 - a state higher ed agency or system;
 - a community college system;
 - a state independent college association;
 - Plus ex-officio representation by AIR and SHEEO
- Staffed and supported by NCES:
 - IPEDS Program Director and NPEC Task Leader (Archie)
 - Support for related contractual work including meeting logistics and R&D work

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Other IPEDS R&D Work: ED Data Integration

- Data Merging Tool
 - Will link publicly available data from IPEDS and FSA Data Centers
 - Utilizes IPEDS Reporting Maps
 - Expected release later in 2012
- IPEDS Reporting Maps
 - Last August, IPEDS Keyholders were asked to do reporting mapping for their institution
 - Keyholders will now verify mapping each year

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Data Integration & IPEDS

- IPEDS Reporting Maps - Lessons Learned
 - Not all Program Participation Agreements (PPAs) are currently accurate
 - Keyholders may not be aware of current PPA data
 - Interest exists for both less, and more, consolidation in reporting relationships

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Proposed Changes to IPEDS for 2013-14

- GR, GR200 will become Winter surveys [upon approval from OMB]

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Proposed Changes to IPEDS for 2014-15 and Beyond

- Will be included in next OMB clearance
 - For 2014-15, 2015-16, and 2016-17
- If approved, proposed changes to IPEDS resulting from these TRPs will be implemented starting in data collection year 2014-15 (preview screens available 2013-14)

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OMB for 2014-15 (so far)

- Academic libraries (TRP 8/11; annual starting 2014-15)
- For-profit finance (TRP 8/12)
- Veterans (TRP 11/11)
- Part-time grad rates (TRP 2/12)
- More GR: non-first-time students (TRP fall 2012)

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
