

Advanced Placement (AP) Exam Cut Scores for Colorado Public Colleges & Universities for GT Pathways General Education Credit (effective for new students starting class on or after July 1, 2016)

You can earn college credit for the AP exams listed in this table on which you score a 3 or higher. The credit is guaranteed to transfer but it's not guaranteed to apply to degree requirements. For instance, if you take two different AP History exams, you could potentially get 6 credits in college-level history. However, if your degree program only requires 3 credits of history (which most do), then only 3 of those 6 credits will apply to the degree and you will be only 3 credits closer to graduation, not 6 credits closer. Most degree programs have the same [GT Pathways general education requirements that are listed in this link](#). A list of degrees that do not contain the GT Pathways curriculum and to which these courses may not apply is listed [in this link](#). Also, Colorado School of Mines has different requirements and students should refer to the [Colorado School of Mines website](#) to determine how AP credits will apply. Students should consult with academic advisors to determine how credit for AP exams can be used most effectively in meeting degree requirements. Please also note:

1. The statewide minimum cut score for awarding GT Pathways credit for the AP exams listed below is 3. It is anticipated that more AP exams will continue to be added to this list. Institutions may award credit for AP exams not listed here but are required to award credit at least for these exams. AP exams taken more than 10 years ago may not be worth credit.
2. At least 3 credit hours shall apply first to the appropriate GT Pathways content area requirements until the amount of credit has been met for that GT Pathways content area. Once a GT Pathways content area requirement has been met, any additional credit may be awarded to fulfill other degree requirements, such as general education, elective or major/prerequisite credit. For example, the GT Pathways history requirement is 3 credits. If a student brings passing cut scores on two different history exams (such as US History and also World History, which qualifies the student for at least 6 credits), then the student shall receive 3 credits applied towards the GT Pathways history requirement. Any additional credits may be awarded to fulfill other degree requirements, such as general education, elective or major/prerequisite credit at the institution's discretion.

In the case of AP science exams, at least 3 credit hours shall apply to the GT-SC2 category (lecture course without laboratory) or, if there is a verified laboratory experience that is discipline-specific to the AP exam or advanced high school course taken, then at least 4 credit hours shall apply to the GT-SC1 category (course with required laboratory). For example, a student seeking biology GT-SC1 credit through the AP Biology exam must have biology laboratory experience specifically, not science laboratory experience in general.

3. Institutions determine the amount of credit to award for AP scores of 4 & 5 but they must award at least 3 credits, or at least 4 credits for GT-SC1 (science courses with labs). Credit awarded shall be transcribed as a course satisfying the appropriate GT Pathways category at the institution. When there is no equivalent, the institution shall create a generic transfer equivalency for a course in that GT Pathways content area (i.e., GT-AH1, GT-AH2, and etc.).

How to Read This Table

The AP exams are arranged by content area—for instance, English exams are listed first. The various AP exams are listed down the left-hand column, along with the GT Pathways/general education requirements they satisfy. Next to that are the exam scores and it should be noted that in some cases, the higher a student scores on an exam the more credit may be awarded. The institutions and the credit they award are listed in the rows. The legend below illustrates in black font the information contained in each column and row. The red, underlined font explains what the information means.
