Phil Fox has spent the vast majority of his career in Colorado education and politics. In 2006 he retired from a 23-year stay at the Colorado Association of School Executives as Deputy Director.

At CASE, he was responsible for the Associations lobbying and political efforts and was regularly detailed out to work on statewide campaigns affecting Colorado education, such as Referendum C, Amendment 39 and TABOR.

Fox was an education policy advisor to former Gov. Richard Lamm for 2 years in the early '80s and cut his teeth on education policy as an analyst and researcher at the Education Commission of the States for 7 years in the 1970s. He served for several years as a research psychologist at the University of Denver Research Institute

Fox was a Peace Corps Volunteer in West Africa in the early '70s. He holds a Master's degree from the University of Oklahoma and a BA from SMU.

Since retirement, Fox has served as a part time advisor to both the current and former Colorado Commissioner of Education.

He is currently the president of the board of Hope Academy Learning Centers.
