

**TOPIC: REPORT ON THE STATUS OF COLORADO STATE
UNIVERSITY-GLOBAL CAMPUS COMPLIANCE**

I. SUMMARY

This agenda item is a report on the status of the CSU-Global degree programs previously reviewed by the Commission on November 13, 2008. At that meeting the Commission approved “The Master of Science in Education: Instructional Development and Online Learning in Higher Education, a Bachelor of Science in Public Management and a Bachelor of Science in Leadership and Organizational Studies pending the resubmission of these degree program proposals with the authoritative assurances from appropriate officials at CSU-Fort Collins and CSU-Pueblo by March 1, 2009”.

To date, neither CSU-Pueblo nor CSU-Fort Collins has resubmitted any of the aforementioned degree program proposals with the authoritative assurances required by Commission action. Department staff has received the following statement from the Provost at CSU-Pueblo on the baccalaureate degree programs,

“I have been authorized by our Faculty Senate to give a provisional certification of the CSU-Global courses, faculty, and programs. The certification is provisional because we have to work out some details about our AACSB accreditation, and our business dean needs to get some assurances from AACSB that we will not face any difficulties.”

Department of Higher Education staff does not believe the statement above meets the Commission directive passed at the November 13, 2008 meeting and seeks Commission guidance on the steps to be taken regarding the CSU-Global degree programs.

It should also be noted that CSU-Global is currently enrolling students in courses leading to an M.S. in Organizational Leadership. This degree program has not been approved by the Commission.
