

TOPIC: LEVERAGING EDUCATIONAL ASSISTANCE PARTNERSHIP PROGRAMS-COLORADO CHRISTIAN UNIVERSITY

I. BACKGROUND

Financial aid allocations for Colorado Christian University were approved for need-based and work-study at the June Commission meeting. Since the June Commission meeting, additional data provided by Colorado Christian University revealed additional eligibility for state funded financial aid. This agenda item presents the staff recommendation for FY 2010 Leveraging Educational Assistance Partnership programs for Colorado Christian University.

II. SUMMARY

The Leveraging Educational Assistance Partnership programs are funded with federal resources and state matching dollars for students with exceptionally high need. The allocation for the Leveraging Educational Assistance Partnership programs are allocated proportionally to institutions based on the eligibility criteria.

III. STAFF ANALYSIS

Colorado Leveraging Educational Assistance Partnership (CLEAP)

The CLEAP program is allocated based on the number of students with high need by institution. Staff recommends that the FY2010 CLEAP allocation for Colorado Christian University in the amount of \$7,064. This program is scheduled to be redesigned in FY 2011.

Supplemental Leveraging Educational Assistance Partnership (SLEAP)

The SLEAP program is allocated proportionally based on the number of students pursuing teacher licensures with high need by institution. Staff recommends that the FY 2010 SLEAP allocation for Colorado Christian University in the amount of \$29,060.

IV. STAFF RECOMMENDATION

That the Commission approves the Fiscal Year 2010 Leveraging Educational Assistance Partnership allocations for Colorado Christian University.
