David Skaggs, Executive Director of the Colorado Department of Higher Education, issued the following statement concerning the opinion issued today by Attorney General John Suthers:

“The Attorney General’s opinion on tuition is welcome and very important in establishing uniform guidance for treating all students fairly and equitably. Due to ambiguities in the law, tuition for these students – who are U.S. citizens and Colorado residents but have undocumented parents – has not been administered consistently across the state. The AG’s opinion removes the ambiguity and ensures all students receive equal treatment. We will all be better off by encouraging these students to further their education and so be able to advance their careers and contribute more to society.”
