NEWS RELEASE: DHE SEEKS HIGH SCHOOL TEACHERS, HIGHER ED FACULTY TO COLLABORATE ON EASING STUDENT TRANSITIONS TO COLLEGE

The Colorado Department of Higher Education is seeking high school teachers and higher education faculty members to participate this summer in its Core to College Initiative, which seeks to promote collaboration between K-12 and higher education in the subjects of math and language arts.

The initiative will bring together high school teachers and higher education faculty in these subjects to improve the transition of students from K-12 to postsecondary. The P20 Partnerships will work on ensuring alignment between high school and higher education courses.

Partnerships will launch in four regions of the state: Metro Denver, Southeast, Northeast and the Western Slope. Interested teachers are asked to send contact information and a brief paragraph describing your interest to Emmy.Glancy@dhe.state.co.us.

Colorado is one of more than 10 states participating in the national Core to College Initiative, funded by Rockefeller Philanthropy Advisors. A statewide summit is scheduled June 10 to kick off the Colorado P20 Partnerships, which are expected to meet four times through December.
