

Rate what voters believe the top 3 state funding priorities should be the next 3 years. [Mark a 1, 2 and 3]


Is There Adequate Funding?

Do voters believe the state adequately fund its public colleges and universities?


Source of Funds

Where do voters believe public university or college in their area receives the largest amount of its funds?


Importance of College Education
