Eligible providers are featured on a public website that helps consumers make informed decisions on training and education opportunities. Once a provider receives approval, <a href="COTrainingProviders.org">COTrainingProviders.org</a> shows the listing in an interactive platform searchable by program name, provider, location and WIOA eligibility.

#### **Lower Costs for Students**

Many programs on the ETPL are eligible under WIOA, meaning students may be eligible to use federal funds to pay for your program.
