

**TOPIC: ANNUAL ELECTION OF COLORADO COMMISSION OF
HIGHER EDUCATION OFFICERS**

I. SUMMARY

Current Colorado Commission on Higher Education's (CCHE) by-laws require the election of officers to take place annually and permits officers to serve for a one-year term. An elected officer can serve up to three consecutive terms. It is required that the officer is re-elected for each term.

II. BACKGROUND

The CCHE by-laws were last revised in May 2014. The proposed amendment to the CCHE bylaws changed the month for the annual election of officers from October to May, along with the ability to serve up to three consecutive one-year terms.

III. STAFF RECOMMENDATIONS

Staff recommends that Commissioners elect new officers to the Colorado Commission on Higher Education.

IV. STATUTORY AUTHORITY

The CCHE bylaws read:

Section 1.3 Election and Terms of Officers: All officers shall be elected at the May meeting of the Commission and if re-elected may serve up to three consecutive years in the position of Chair, Vice-Chair or Treasurer, except the Secretary whose term shall be coterminous with his or her term as Executive Director.
