Eligible providers are featured on a public website that helps consumers make informed decisions on training and education opportunities. Once a provider receives approval, COTrainingProviders.org shows the listing in an interactive platform searchable by program name, provider, location and WIOA eligibility.

Lower Costs for Students

Many programs on the ETPL are eligible under WIOA, meaning students may be eligible to use federal funds to pay for your program.
