GE 25 Council February 13, 2006 MEETING MINUTES

#### **Meeting Attendees:**

The meeting began with discussion and decisions concerning the following **Action Items**:

- 1. **We reviewed a second draft of the Chair's Cover Sheet.** The goal of the form was to combine signatures from review committees with a signoff from the committee chair so that the CCHE could have a record for the archives separate from what is returned to the institutions (the review committee's substantive evaluation). The Council discussed the draft of the form and decided to have Vicki conduct major revisions on the version they reviewed. **Update:** Attached is the 3<sup>rd</sup> iteration of the Chair's Cover Sheet and the version used at the Course review on the 24<sup>th</sup>/Feb. GE 25 will have this lasted version of the document on the agenda for further/final discussion/approval at their March 13<sup>th</sup> meeting.
- 2. Solicit names from members of GE 25 for the assembly of the Advisors/Registrars sub-committee of the GE 25 Council Vicki asked that members of GE 25 nominate representatives from their institutions for participation on the Advisors/Registrars Advisory Sub-committee for GE 25. March 1, 2006 was established as a deadline for the submission of nominations. <u>Update:</u> Vicki will share the make-up of the advisory subgroup w/ GE 25 at their March 13<sup>th</sup> meeting.
- 3. The GE 25 reviewed a draft of the gtPathways Changes to Approved gtPathways Courses Form. There was minimal discussion, and due to time constraints the GE 25 decided to delegate the revising of the document to Alan Lamborn and Vicki. <u>Update:</u> As of March 9, 2006, no revisions have been completed. This will be tabled and added as an action item to the March agenda of the GE 25 Council.
- 4. The GE 25 reviewed two versions of the gtPathways Planning Guide. As part of the discussion, the GE recommended that the name of the document/page at the website be changed to gtPathways Curriculum Guide all agreed; future revisions to the gtPathways website will include the revised terminology. It was agreed by the GE 25 membership that the document, entitled Structure of gtPathways Curriculum, Effective Fall 2006, and dated November 16, 2005, would be the document posted as a page labeled gtPathways Curriculum Guide at the gtPathways website. The guide would be provide clear, concise documentation concerning effective dates and be posted at the gtPathways site with the

appropriate changes (combining verbiage from various drafts of the document). See final version attached to the March 2006 Agenda for the GE 25 Council.

- Review and revise of the FAQs at the gtPathways website. PLEASE PROVIDE ME WITH SOME EXAMPLES OF FAQS (from your institution) BY FRIDAY MARCH 3, 2006 SO THAT WE CAN COMPLETE, (FOR NOW), THIS PORTION OF THE gtPathways website. Update: As of Thursday March 9, 2006, NO institutions have responded to this request.

The following recommendations were made at the February 13<sup>th</sup> GE 25 meeting concerning the (current state) of the gtPathways website:

\* There should be (two) tiers of information/2 general areas of information configured as follows:

One <u>Tier</u> – for students and parents visiting the site and containing General Information; <u>Another Tier</u> – specifically for institutional personnel, also containing General Information but in addition, listing information specific to gtPathways, i.e. approved courses, etc.

- \* It was recommended that the following be ON THE FIRST PAGE OF THE WEBSITE: the gtPathways Planning Guide, the updated List of gtPathways Courses, including effective dates (as discussed and agreed to in prior GE 25 meetings).
- \* It was recommended that a new section be added and prominently listed at the site and entitled: "Changes 2006"
  - The thrust of these recommendations is to have 2 separate areas of focus for the website: one for the student/general public and another for Institutions/Institutional personnel. **Update:** Many changes have been made to

the site and even more need to be completed. The site is yet under construction (and the going is slow, due to "staffing issues" at the CCHE).

#### **Discussion Items:**

- The King Bill and (4) Competency testing. THE COMMISSION SHALL, IN CONSULTATION WITH EACH PUBLIC INSTITUTION OF HIGHER EDUCATION, DEFINE A PROCESS FOR STUDENTS TO TEST OUT OF CORE COURSES, INCLUDING SPECIFYING USE OF A NATIONAL TEST OR THE CRITERIA FOR APPROVING INSTITUTIONALLY DEVISED TESTS. STUDENTS SHALL BE GRANTED CREDIT FOR THE CORE COURSES THEY SUCCESSFULLY TEST OUT OF, FREE OF TUITION FOR THOSE COURSES.

#### **Discussion Questions:**

## Begin dialog with a discussion concerning competency testing for the beginning level of the Communication content area.

The GE 25 discussed various issues of concern relative to this clause of the King Bill and specifically discussed the following: Negotiated cut points, credits toward degree, agreed upon use of assessments. Members of the GE 25 unanimously agreed to pose this discussion topic to the Communication Content group at the Feb 24<sup>th</sup> Review Day as well as defer this discussion topic to the Faculty Advisory Sub-group of the GE 25 Council. **Update:** Awaiting documentation from the Communication group's chair concerning their Feb 24<sup>th</sup> discussion. Will provide this as it is received.

- Discuss the possibility of a) a CCHE conference designed to inform all institutions concerning recent revisions and additions to forms/processes of the gtPathways program; or b) CCHE personnel will travel to the institutions in order to present the changes/revisions in person (and over the course of the next few months). What is the preference of the GE 25 membership?

The GE 25 membership appeared split over this recommendation, with some members thinking it was a good idea that could possibly yield some utility for the public institutions within the state. Other GE members indicated that they thought such a recommendation was not necessary, as members of the GE and AC could adequately handle this task of the gtPathways. Still other members indicated that they believed the majority of courses had been nominated for consideration/placement into the gtPathways curriculum, and therefore such a recommendation was not necessary. It was recommended that Vicki submit a proposal to the GE 25 at their March 2006 meeting concerning this proposal and that the GE 25 have additional discussion concerning the proposal.
