We are currently targeting fall 2020 to begin collecting PLA data for SURDS reporting (making first data available in fall 2021). Discussion surrounding the level of difficulty in capturing and reporting*



certain data elements was addressed – for example, CSU is currently not capturing assessment scores so would not be able to report those. Chris and Carl will design a survey to collect information regarding how IHE's are currently entering PLA in their SIS's and will ask for degrees of difficulty in reporting to SURDS for each data field. The survey results will be used to help draft the PLA reporting policy.
