

## SECTION III

### PART T POLICY REGARDING SCORING OF REQUESTS FOR STATE FUNDED CAPITAL CONSTRUCTION OR RENEWAL, AND CAPITAL IT PROJECTS

#### **1.00 Scoring Criteria**

- 1.1 As required by C.R.S. 23-1-106, the Commission shall submit a list of prioritized capital construction and renewal projects for state funding consideration to the Capital Development Committee by November 1st of each year.

The Commission will use a set of published scoring criteria to inform their prioritization. Scoring criteria for capital construction and renewal will include the following:

- #1: Health and Safety (10 points)
- #2: Reduction of Deferred Maintenance (5 points)
- #3: Other Fund Sources (8 points)
- #4: Space Needs Analysis (10 points)
- #5: Achieves Master Plan Goals (5 points)
- #6: Governing Board Priority (20 Points)

- 1.2 The Commission shall submit a list of prioritized capital IT projects for state funding consideration to the Joint Technology Committee by November 1st of each year.

The Commission will use a set of published scoring criteria to inform their prioritization. Scoring criteria for capital IT will include the following:

- #1: IT Health, Security and Industry Standards (10 points)
- #2: Other Fund Sources (8 points)
- #3: Quality of Planning/Proposal (10 points)
- #4: Achieves Master Plan Goals (5 points)
- #5: Governing Board Priority (10 points)

#### **2.00 Review Timeline**

The Fiscal Affairs and Audit Committee or a special working group of commissioners shall review both sets of criteria every five years. The review process should consider feedback from relevant stakeholders including the state institutions of higher education.

The Fiscal Affairs and Audit Committee or a special working group of commissioners may review and revise either the entire criteria, or a subset of it on a more regular basis.
