



SB18-206 Compliance Reporting

In compliance with SB18-206 and Colorado Revised Statute (CRS) [23-1-113.5](#), the current admissions/enrollment report is submitted for Colorado State University.

Chart 1. New Applicants' Admission and Yield Rates by Residency— Fall 2020 to Fall 2025



As shown in Chart 1, the admissions rate over the last five years is 88% for nonresidents and resident applicants; additionally, the yield rate is 24% for residents and 12% for nonresidents. The numbers demonstrate that nonresident students in the admissions process are not displacing Colorado residents.

All applications submitted to Colorado State University are reviewed holistically, beyond just GPA. Other factors considered may include employment, leadership activities, involvement in clubs or sports, community service activities etc. Additionally, academic performance trends, student essays, and letters of recommendation are also considered.

This report also demonstrates that the proportions of residents to non-residents and international students are well within compliance and keep with our land grant heritage. Among the three most recent entering classes, 65% are Colorado residents (excluding international students) and the median HS GPA is 3.76 for nonresidents and 3.78 for residents. Among all enrolled RI (state-funded) students in three most recent fall semesters, about 5% are international.
