

## Colorado Free Application Day Instructions

### Public Four-Year Colleges and Universities

Each public four-year college and university will have a unique fee waiver process; some will ask you to submit codes, others will ask you to select an answer from a dropdown menu, and some have no special instructions. Please read instructions carefully as you prepare to submit applications on Tuesday, October 13, 2020. For institutions using fee waiver codes, we have highlighted the codes in **red**.

<a href="#">Adams State University</a>	Enter the discount code <b>freeappday</b> at the end of Adams State's online application form.
<a href="#">Colorado Mesa University</a>	At the end of the application, choose Pay Now/Have Promo Code and use the code <b>COFREE</b> to waive the \$30 fee.
<a href="#">Colorado School of Mines</a>	No special steps are necessary for Colorado residents to qualify for Colorado Free Application Day; your fee will automatically be waived when you submit your application on October 13.
Colorado State University <a href="#">Freshmen/First-Year Application</a> <a href="#">Transfer Application</a>	<p><b>Common Application - for Freshman/First-Year Applicants:</b> Within the CSU Member Questions section, you'll see this required prompt: Are you eligible for a CSU application fee waiver through one (or more) of the following affiliations? Choose <b>Colorado Free Application Day</b> (Colorado residents only) in the dropdown. No additional codes or actions are necessary as long as you submit your Common App AND CSU Member Questions on Oct. 13, 2020.</p> <p><b>CSU Application - for Transfer &amp; Second Bachelor Applicants:</b> No special steps are necessary for Colorado residents to qualify for Colorado Free Application Day; your fee will automatically be waived when you submit your application on Oct. 13, 2020.</p>
<a href="#">Colorado State University Global</a>	When requested, enter the promo code <b>CORISES</b> during the application process. Once entered, the application fee will automatically be waived.
<a href="#">Colorado State University-Pueblo</a>	Enter the code <b>FreeAppDayCO</b> on the Fee Waiver page of the application.
<a href="#">Fort Lewis College</a>	First-time freshmen: Enter the code <b>COLORISES</b> when submitting an online application.

	<p>Within the MSU Denver Questions section, you'll see this required prompt:</p> <p>1) <b>Do you intend to use one of these school-specific fee waivers?</b> Choose <b>Colorado Free Application Day</b> in the dropdown.</p> <p>2) You will then see another required field: <b>Please provide your MSU Denver fee waiver code here.</b> Enter <b>FreeAppDayCO</b> in the field provided.</p> <p>Your fee will be waived as long as you submit your completed Common App and MSU Denver Member Questions on Oct. 13, 2020.</p>
<p>University of Colorado Boulder</p> <p><a href="#">Freshmen/First-Year Application</a></p> <p><a href="#">Transfer Application</a></p>	<p><b>Common Application (for first-year, freshmen applicants):</b> Within the CU Boulder Member Questions section, you'll see this required prompt: <b>Do you intend to use one of these school-specific fee waivers?</b> Choose <b>Colorado Free Application Day (Colorado residents only)</b> in the dropdown. You will then see another required field: <b>Please provide your University of Colorado Boulder fee waiver code here.</b> Enter <b>FreeAppDayCO</b> in the field provided. Your fee will be waived as long as you submit your completed Common App and Member Questions on Oct. 13, 2020.</p> <p><b>CU Boulder Transfer Application:</b> No special steps are necessary for Colorado residents to qualify for Colorado Free Application Day; your fee will automatically be waived when you submit your application on Oct. 13, 2020.</p>
<p><a href="#">University of Colorado Denver</a></p>	<p><b>CU Denver Application (open to all applicants):</b> After submitting your application, you'll be taken to your "Application Portal". Select that you have a Promo Code, enter <b>FreeAppDayCO</b> and click submit. Your application fee will be waived within 24 hours.</p> <p><b>Common Application (first-year, freshmen applicants only):</b> Within the school-specific fee waivers section, choose Colorado Free Application Day from the dropdown. You will then see another required field asking for your fee waiver code. Enter <b>FreeAppDayCO</b> and your application fee will be waived.</p>
<p><a href="#">University of Colorado Colorado Springs</a></p>	<p>On <a href="https://www.uccs.edu/admissionsenrollment/apply-uccs-today">https://www.uccs.edu/admissionsenrollment/apply-uccs-today</a>: freshmen and transfer students can <b>select the option to pay by "mail"</b> and we will waive the fee in our system.</p> <p>If a student uses the <b>Common Application</b>, they can select the <b>"Colorado Free App Day 2020"</b> and that will allow them to submit.</p>
<p><a href="#">University of Northern Colorado</a></p>	<p><b>Common Application:</b> Within the University of Northern Colorado Member Questions section, answer these two questions like this:</p>

	<p>Do you intend to use one of these school-specific fee waivers? Answer: <b>Yes</b>  Please provide your University of Northern Colorado fee waiver code here. Answer: <b>freeappday</b></p> <p><b>Bear App:</b> There is nothing you need to do. Simply submit the application on Oct. 13, 2020, and the fee will automatically be waived for Colorado residents.</p>
<a href="#">Western Colorado University</a>	<p><b>Western Application:</b> On the application page titled '<b>Fee Waiver</b>', indicate that you have a fee waiver code and then enter <b>freeappdayco</b> in the waiver code box. As long as you submit on Oct. 13, 2020, you will see the payment waived in your application portal.</p> <p><b>Common Application</b> (for Freshmen applicants only):</p> <p>1) Within the Western <b>Member Questions</b> section, you'll see this required prompt: <b>Do you intend to use one of these school-specific fee waivers?</b> Choose <b>freeappdayco</b> in the dropdown menu.</p> <p>2) You will then see another required field: <b>Please provide your Western fee waiver code here.</b> Enter <b>freeappdayco</b> in the field provided. Your fee will be waived as long as you submit your completed Common Application and Member Questions on Oct. 13, 2020.</p>
