**** The Colorado Community College System (not each individual community college) is encouraged to send a thirty person (30) delegation consisting of five (5) faculty members from each content area to participate in these discussions.

**** Aims and Colorado Mountain College are encouraged to send one (1) faculty member from *each content area* to participate in these discussions.

- Go South on I-25
- Take exit 207B to merge onto US-85 S /S Platte River Dr toward Santa Fe Drive

- Make a U-turn at W Lake Ave
- Destination will be on the right

From the South

- Go North on I-25
- Take exit 194 to merge onto CO-470 W / E470 W toward Grand Jct
- Exit onto US-85 N / S Santa Fe Dr
- Continue straight onto S Santa Fe Dr
- Turn right onto S Sumner St
- Take the 1st right onto W College Dr
- Destination will be on the right
